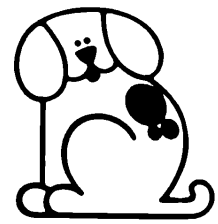

Come hear what Ohio lawmakers & anti-breeding activists plan for dog breeders, owners, exhibitors, & enthusiasts in the 2009-10 legislative session.

Ohio is one of 34 states targeted for breeder regulation by the Humane Society of the US. Although no anti-breeding bills were introduced as of March 25, the word from the activists is that last year's failed bills will appear again with even tighter restrictions. These bills are likely to include standards that could drive many breeders away and reduce the availability of well-bred dogs for pets, shows, and performance events.



Along with breeder regulation bills yet to be filed, lawmakers will make decisions on HB 55 and HB 70, two bills to increase penalties for animal cruelty, and HB 79 a bill to REMOVE breed-specific language from Ohio State Law. Information on these bills and on local licensing, zoning, and nuisance laws will be presented.

Miami Township Civic Center is located on Meijer Drive off Ohio Route 28. From I-275, turn towards Blanchester on Route 28, keeping left to continue on Route 28. Meijer Drive is opposite Wolfpen-Pleasant Hill Road; the Civic Center is located on the right about a mile down the road. Or follow the Route 28 By-pass, turn left (north) on Wolfpen Pleasant-Hill, and cross Route 28 to Meijer Drive
